Under the supervision of the Primary Care Manager, in conjunction with the Land Based Program Coordinator, the Harm Reduction Nurse will provide nursing care within their full scope as an RPN/RN working in land-based detox treatment and the Primary Care Clinic. The Harm Reduction Nurse assists in overseeing the quality of services being delivered and developing nursing care plans within the land-based detox treatment, and other health programs. The Harm Reduction Nurse works collaboratively as a member of the interdisciplinary team and will participate in the development, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of land-based detox treatment and other health programs.
